



VERTICAL PUMP SETS - GENERAL DESCRIPTION

As a standard, these pump sets are built with various capacities and they are composed of:

- A vertical welded sheet steel tank with perfect vacuum seal;
- A rotary vane vacuum pump to be selected according to the required suction flow rate and level of vacuum;
- A digital vacuum switch for adjusting the level of vacuum within which to operate;
- A vacuum gauge for a direct reading of the level of vacuum in the tank;
- Switchgear enclosed in a special metal watertight casing;
- A manual valve for vacuum interception;
- A cock for condensation drainage.

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As for energy consumption, in both cases these pump sets offer many advantages, since the pump operates only to restore vacuum in the tank within the preset values and its interventions depend exclusively on the quantity of air that is actually sucked at the service.
